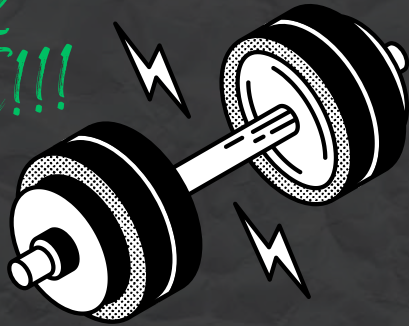

Meet Alex, a 37-year-old African Gray parrot whose intelligence and charm have won the hearts of all who know him. Owned by Rose Laneux and April Miller, Alex is a source of joy and comfort, greeting them with cheerful words. Native to the rainforests of Africa, Alex is part of a species renowned for its ability to mimic human speech and solve complex problems. His red tail is a telltale sign that he is a male. He loves having his head rubbed, and when talked to, he always responds with fun phrases, often teasing the dogs by saying "Come here!" to get their attention. When Alex bows his head, he's trying to get your attention or trying to focus on what you're doing. African Grays like Alex are known to know over 1,000 words and can speak in full sentences, starting to talk around 12-18 months of age. They are also very empathic and sensitive to people's feelings, offering comfort when needed. Alex has a taste for fruits and vegetables. These amazing birds can live up to 80 years or more, but sadly, they are endangered. Alex is not just a pet, but a lifelong companion and a reminder of the incredible bonds we share with animals and the importance of protecting them.

# Brownie Mint Trifle!



## Ingredients:

- **1 9x13 Pan of Prepared Brownies**
- **1 3.4 oz Package Vanilla Instant Pudding Mix**
- **1 1/2 cups cold milk**
- **1 cup of whipped topping (cool whip)**
- **1/2 tsp peppermint extract**
- **sprinkles if desired**

## Directions:

1. **In a bowl whisk together the pudding mix, & cold milk until smooth.**
2. **Stir in the peppermint extract and refrigerate for 5 -10 minutes.**
3. **While it is chilling, Cut your prepared brownies into 1 inch squares, and set aside.**
4. **Remove the pudding from the fridge and fold in the whipped topping.**
5. **In serving cups layer a few pieces of brownie, then a couple tablespoons of the pudding mix. Repeat the layering 2 - 3 times.**
6. **Top with sprinkles or additional whipped topping.**
