Prepare Your Furnace for Fall

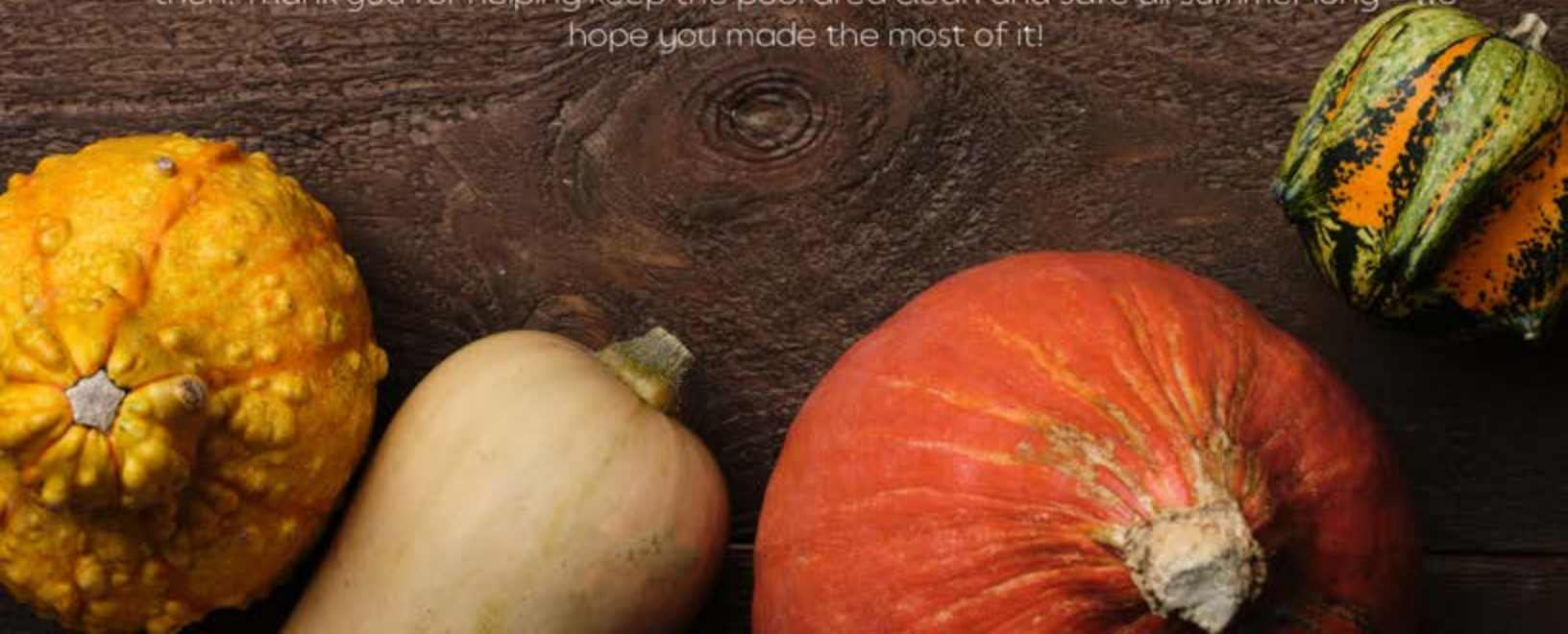
As colder weather approaches, now is a great time to turn on your heater briefly to ensure it's working properly before it's needed daily. When you first turn on your furnace for the season, you might notice a slight odor—this is completely normal and typically caused by dust that has settled on internal components during the summer being heated. The smell should go away within a few minutes to an hour. However, if it persists or seems unusual (like a smoky or electrical smell), please contact us right away. Testing your system now helps ensure everything is running smoothly and gives us time to address any issues before the colder temperatures arrive.

Fresh Filters Coming Soon

Maintenance will be coming through soon to change furnace filters as part of routine seasonal upkeep. No action is needed on your part. Thank you for your cooperation!

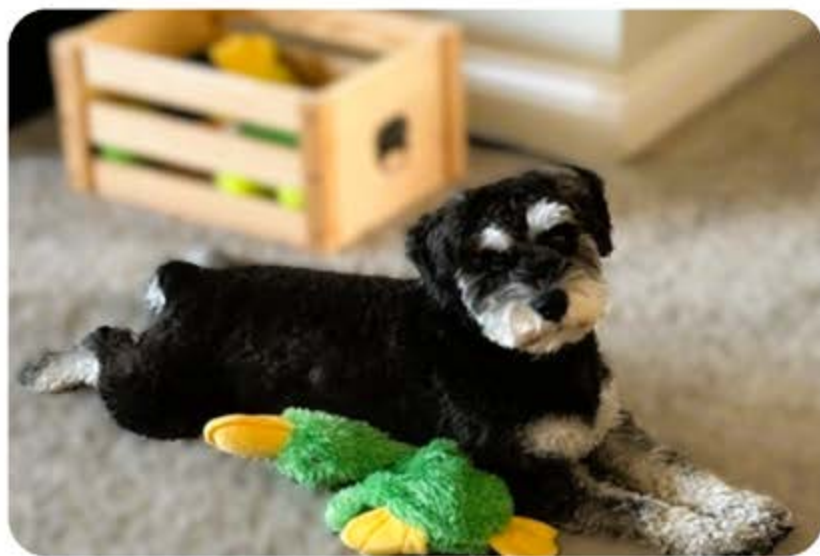
Last Call for Pool Time!
